FDJ INTENSIVE WORKSHOP GRADES 2 - 12

Students will be placed according to ability and age. The first day of class, students will be assessed to ensure proper placement within the workshop.

This workshop offers the opportunity to experience our well known summer intensives in a structured format providing a nurturing, professional environment. Out of town guest artists will join our professional faculty and present workshops geared to the learning process and growth of each student. Summer training is crucial for a dancer to continue to develop technique, establish a strong foundation, enhance artistic qualities and achieve correct posture and alignment on a daily basis. This daily repetition will provide each student the ability to soar and progress at their own pace. The workshop will be held for 4 weeks. Students can take from 1 week to all 4 weeks. It is strongly recommended students participate in at least 2 weeks to receive the benefits of the program.

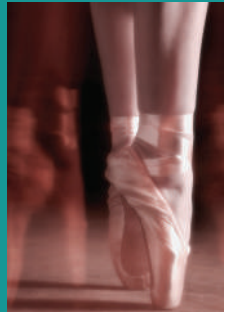

Curriculum will vary according to level placement in order to focus on the technical development of each dancer in a nurturing, positive environment. Daily repetition will provide each student the ability to soar and progress at their own pace. The workshop will be held for 2 weeks. It is strongly recommended students participate in both weeks to receive the full benefit of the program. 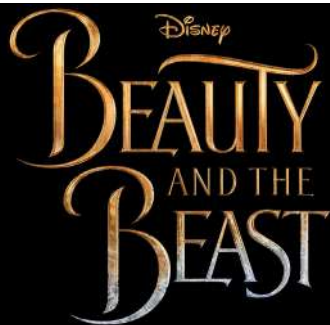
