WHY DO WE COMPETE?

We at MJPAA consider participation in competition to be a reflection of our Academy's solid reputation for quality, not simply training of our students, but on how we influence them as people. The goal of our competition season is not about winning trophies and awards. We compete to give our members a chance to grow and learn from the competition experience. We encourage each member to attend as much of the competition as possible. This is an invaluable learning experience as well as an important part of good sportsmanship and team building. They will learn to set goals, how to strive to achieve those goals and acceptance of constructive criticism. These are experiences that will enhance their overall development as an artist as well as a person.

EARLY IS ON TIME!!

- All pieces have a call time that is a minimum of 2 hours prior to the estimated performance time. This is crucial for the dancer to be prepared both mentally and physically before their performances!

- ALL performers must check-in with a Director when arriving. ANY late arrivals may result in being removed from pieces.

- Please find assigned dressing rooms after you arrive.

- Please remember how important it is to warm-up before a performance. Performers will dance their best when the body is FULLY warm and ready to execute proper technique!

PERFORMER ETIQUETTE

- All Universal Movement members are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times, setting a good example both in and out of the Academy.

- Members are expected to follow all the rules of the Company and represent MJPAA at ALL TIMES!
- Please remember to be kind and respectful to your teammates, other studios and competition staff.

- It is the performer's responsibility to be fully stretched and warmed up ready to perform. The performer is also responsible for being in proper costume, makeup, hair and warm ups.

- NO member is to approach a competition staff member. Only Directors are allowed to check in routines.

PARENT ETIQUETTE

- Parents of company members are expected to be an exemplary member to the Academy, to support and be kind to each other, respect all instructors, the owner/Artistic Director - Mary Jo Scanio, and all of the children of MJPAA.

- Parents are to be supportive of their child, their team, and allow their Directors to make the best possible decision they can for their children, knowing they have the child's best interest at Heart!

- Let the Directors do their jobs. Few things are harder on kids than receiving one message from their Director and contradictory messages from their parents. Directors will gather and rehearse students ONLY!

- NO Parent is to approach a competition staff member at ANY TIME. Only Directors are allowed to check in routines

There is absolutely NO VIDEO RECORDING permitted! Anyone caught recording a routine with a video camera, still camera or phone, will result in disaualification for the Academv!
