#### WHY DO WE COMPETE?

We at MJPAA consider participation in competition to be a reflection of our Academy's solid reputation for quality, not simply training of our students, but on how we influence them as people. #### **EARLY IS ON TIME!!**

- All pieces have a call time that is a minimum of 2 hours prior to the estimated performance time. This is crucial for the dancer to be prepared both mentally and physically before their performances!
  - ALL performers must check-in with a Director when arriving. ANY late arrivals may result in being removed from pieces.
    - Please find assigned dressing rooms after you arrive.
- Please remember how important it is to warm-up before a performance. Performers will dance their best when the body is FULLY warm and ready to execute proper technique!

  - Let the Directors do their jobs. Few things are harder on kids than receiving one message from their Director and contradictory messages from their parents. Directors will gather and rehearse students ONLY!
